

## **Accounting Advisory Board Mentorship Program**

Each year, declared accounting majors are selected to participate in the Accounting Advisory Board Mentorship Program. The objective of this program is to match accounting students with accounting professionals who will coach, provide advice, and guide the students as they consider career opportunities, development professional department skills, and build their professional network.

To be eligible for this program, students must meet the following minimum requirements:

- Be currently enrolled in ACC 3023 Intermediate Accounting I
- Be recommended by the student's ACC 3023 Intermediate Accounting I instructor
- Be a declared accounting major
- Have a 3.0 or higher overall GPA
- Have grades of B or better in all accounting courses completed
- Have a midterm grade of B or better in all accounting courses currently in progress

The number of students selected for the program depends on the number of professionals volunteering as mentors, so slots are limited. The term of the mentorship is one year and includes a minimum of two mentor/mentee meetings in each long semester.

A call for applications will be made by the Department of Accounting during each spring and fall semester. The students selected will be notified by e-mail and will be invited to a Mentorship Mixer to meet their mentor.
