VIP Admissions

Master of Accountancy (MACY)

Students who are near graduating with a BBA in Accounting from UTSA, or who have recently graduated with a BBA in Accounting from UTSA, may be offered an invitation for expedited admission to the MACY program. The admission process for these students will not include the GMAT, letters of recommendation, or a personal statement. Students receiving this invitation must have an overall gpa of 3.0 or higher, an accounting gpa of 3.3 or higher for all upper-level accounting courses, a grade in ACC 3023 Intermediate I and ACC 3033 Intermediate II of B or higher, and the recommendations of two accounting faculty members.

5-Year Program (MACY)

Students interested in the 5-Year Program typically apply during the last semester of their junior year (after completing ACC 3023 Intermediate Accounting I) in the undergraduate accounting program. Some students may be offered an invitation for expedited admission to the 5-Year Program. The admission process for these students will not include the GMAT, letters of recommendation, or a personal statement. These students will have completed ACC 3023 Intermediate Accounting I and one additional upper-level accounting course (typically ACC 3123 Cost Analysis or ACC 3113 Accounting Information Systems). The average grade for these two (or more) courses must be 3.3 or higher, and the grade in ACC 3023 must be a B or higher). In addition, these students will have a 3.0 or higher overall gpa and have recommendations from two accounting faculty members.

You must be invited to apply for the MACY program with VIP admissions. Students may not request VIP admission to the MACY program.
